## ASSISTANT PROFESSOR POSITIONS

### Tenure Track Assistant Professor Positions in Electrical and Computer Engineering

The Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering (ECE) at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette invites applications for two tenure-track Assistant Professor Positions in the areas of Computer Engineering, Energy Systems and Smart grid technologies. Areas of special interests include: smart systems; embedded systems; internet of things Systems and Applications; smart and micro-grids; sustainable and renewable energy systems; power systems planning and analysis; and Robotics. Applicants must have a Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering, Computer Engineering or closely related field, preferably with a B.S.E.E. from an ABET accredited program. Applicants must demonstrate a solid publication record, and exhibit the potential to establish a strong externally sponsored research program.

Successful candidates are expected to contribute to undergraduate and graduate programs, develop a strong externally-funded research program in collaboration with existing campus and departmental faculty, and local industry.

The Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering is one of five engineering departments in the College of Engineering at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette. The department has a very strong ABET accredited undergraduate program and a growing graduate program. There are currently nine electrical engineering faculty members, with considerable growth expected over the next two years (see <https://ee.louisiana.edu/>).

Applications should include a cover letter, complete resume, research and teaching statements and the names and addresses of three references.
