

## AWARDS FOR ECE EDUCATORS

Two of our professional societies are involved with awards for the outstanding ECE educators we have in our colleges and universities today. As Department Heads/Chairs, you are in a unique position to recommend faculty members in your departments or programs for these awards, and we ask you to consider preparing and submitting such nominations.

No doubt you are aware of the two awards sponsored by the Hewlett-Packard Company. The Frederick Emmons Terman Award, administered through the ASEE-ECE Division, has been given continuously for 46 years for young educator textbook writing. The list of recipients is a virtual "Who' Who" in ECE education today. The Harriett B. Rigas Award, administered through the IEEE Education Society and first given in 1995, recognizes women faculty members who contribute to ECE education and also enhance the opportunities for women colleagues. This award is named for a former ECEDHA member who chaired three ECE programs in the 1970s and 1980s.
