



IEEE Standards Education Grants for University Student Design Projects using Technical Standards

**\$500 Grants for Students with additional
\$300 Grants for Faculty Mentors**

The IEEE is offering grants to both students and faculty mentors to help with student design projects that include an industry standards component.* IEEE will publish the results as a Student Application Paper.

Requirements:

Student(s) beginning a design, capstone or graduate project will submit an Application and Abstract Summary describing the project, which includes:

1. Summarizing the project goal (i.e., what are you trying to build?).
2. Describing which standards are being considered to achieve the project goal.
3. Statement of endorsement from faculty mentor/advisor.

Student(s) must agree to submit a final Student Application Paper to the IEEE upon completion of the project.

Important Dates:

- Applications may be submitted for consideration at any time throughout the year.
- Deadlines for 2014 and 2015 student grant applications:
 - 30 January
 - 15 March
 - 15 June
 - 15 October
- Final Student Application Papers are due within six months of approval of application.
